
program helps to organize, coordinate, undertake risk, and handle economic uncertainty in an effective manner.









ACHIEVEMENT THROUGH ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMMES

TNSI – Tamil Nadu Student Innovators is the flagship student Entrepreneurship challenge organized every year by EDII-TN for identifying, mentoring, and encouraging the budding student entrepreneur. EDII-TN has taken many initiatives under IEDP in a hub to promote entrepreneurial culture in Higher Educational Institution in the State. Tamil Nadu Student Innovator Award for the year 2021-2022 was started in the year December 2021 in which 7,568 ideas have been registered at stage-1, and 4,657 ideas were recommended for the next level by EDII-TN. In stage II, 800 ideas were selected and ideation camps were conducted across the state. Through ideation camp, 146 ideas were selected. Out of these ideas, 54 teams were chosen for final pitch which was conducted at Anna University, and finally 25 teams were selected for TNSI 2021 Award. Among them, our college students Sai Sowmiya, Divyadharshini, and Monica from Department of Biotechnology have been selected for the TNSI 2021 Innovator Award with the title of 'Boneknit Bandaid'.
